

Covid-19 Procedures for Pine Ridge

Any time you are in or around the Pine Lodge, wear a mask and try to stay at least 6-feet from anyone else. If you don't have a mask, we will give you one. Registration/Check-in, Waiver signing and Downloading are inside Pine Lodge; Start, Finish and Instruction are outside.

Use the hand sanitizer whenever you feel it is necessary.

If you are **not a club member**, you must sign a waiver. In signing the waiver, you are agreeing to abide by these Covid-19 Procedures. Go to where the Waiver sign is and fill out a waiver form (PRINT CLEARLY) and **bring both the waiver form and the pen** to the Registration Table to pay for your entry.

If you are a **club member**, just go to the Registration Table.

If you are **preregistered**: Registration volunteers will give you a map and in a plastic bag that has your name on the back.

If you are **not preregistered** Registration volunteers will give you a map in a plastic bag that has an SI-card number on the back.

If you need **instruction**, it is available only from 11am to Noon. If you are early, you have to wait – please stay socially distanced while waiting.

When you are done at Registration, go to where the Computer sign is, get the SI-card you will be using (if borrowing), and verify your computer entry. Then, **Clear and Check your SI-card**.

With your name and SI-card number in the computer, you may go to the Start (just outside the Lodge) or to Instruction if you need it. At the Start, you may remove your mask and start. If there is someone else at the Start, stay socially distanced until s/he leaves, then wait at least one minute before starting yourself.

While on the course, if you choose to drink at a water stop, please use the hand sanitizer both before and after drinking.

The Finish is also just outside the Lodge. After you finish, take a moment to catch your breath if necessary, put your mask back on and go to the Download station inside. If you borrowed an SI-card and/or compass, give that back at the Computer station. Then, continue to wear the mask and socially distance while around the Lodge.
